### Day-to-day programm

#### Tour profile

This route combines roads without traffic, paved paths as well as some short off-road sections. Also profile includes everything from long flat sections to some rolling hills, which are not very steep though.

#### Day 1: Prague - Telc, approx. 160 km by bus

The guided tour usually starts in Prague on the scheduled day at 9.a.m. Self-guided tours and non-scheduled tours start at your request. After a short welcome briefing you will be transferred to Telc. After check-in in your hotel the bike handover takes place and afterwards you still have enough time for an extensive walk around the old city of Telc.

#### Day 2: Telc - Jindrichuv Hradec, approx. 40 km

Today you can start with an optional visit to Telc Renaissance Chateau and world-renowned square.. Take a lunch on the way at Strmilov and do not forget sightseeing in the town of Jindrichuv Hradec, optional visit to the castle in Jindrichuv Hradec.

#### Day 3: Jindrichuv Hradec - Trebon, approx. 45 km

An easy route through the deep forests of the Czech border area and through the Trebon region of fishponds and





man-made lakes. Lunch at the border hotel at Peršlák or at U Emy Destinové restaurant. Walking tour of the medieval town of Trebon, an optional visit to the chateau, the chateau gardens and the Schwarzenberg Tomb.

#### Day 4: Trebon - Cesky Krumlov, approx. 60 km

This is a strenuous ride through partially hilly countryside mostly on tarmac roads. Cesky Krumlov is probably the most splendid medieval town in the Czech Republic with the second largest chateau in the country. Lunch in one of many villages and small towns on the way.

#### Day 5: Cesky Krumlov, day off

Discover and enjoy this pearl among Czech towns. Optional programmes: sightseeing, visit of Cesky Krumlov castle and gardens, cycling trip in the surrounding area of Cesky Krumlov or rafting on the Vltava River.

#### Day 6: Cesky Krumlov – Hluboka nad Vltavou, approx. 42 km

Easy ride following the Vltava River passing through Èeské Budejovice, the hometown of Budweiser beer. Lunch at Ceske Budejovice square. After the tour of the city we will ride the remaining 12 km to Hluboka where you will spend the night.

#### Day 7: Roundtrip Hluboka, approx. 52 km

Optional chateau excursion in Hluboka at the end of the tour. Departure from Hluboka to Prague by minibus in the late afternoon. Arrival in Prague, check-in to the hotel, free time in Prague.

#### Day 8: Prague

Individual departure or extended stay.
